The Chasing Zero Infections Series provides hospitals with the latest information, practices and assistance in eliminating hospital acquired infections (HAI) including: CAUTI, CLABSI, SSI, VAE/IVAC, MRSA and Antibiotic Stewardship through both didactic webinars and interactive coaching calls.
