#### MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT FOR LABOR & DELIVERY

#### CONTINUES WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AND RETENTION

- Bolstering Graduate Medical Education by expanding Slots for Docs and creating the statewide GME Committee
- Modernizes and increases the award amounts for the FRAME loan repayment program - now includes behavioral health professions!
- **Expands LINE Program** to increase nursing development partnerships between hospitals and nursing schools
- Training, Education, and Clinicals in Health (TEACH) program to expand health care professional training into more rural and community health settings
- Extends the work of the **Florida Center For Nursing** to submit an annual data report on the previous academic year

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## HEALTH CARE INNOVATION & COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH

- Expands the Mobile Response Team program to cover all ages that are experiencing a mental health crisis in all counties to ensure timely crisis de-escalation services that have prevented unnecessary hospitalizations. 82% of calls responded to by an MRT team did not result in a hospitalization - ending the perpetual revolving door of the emergency department.
- Creates a 10-year revolving loan program **to incentivize health care innovation**. Hospitals will be able to seek loans to implement new models of care that deliver high-quality outcomes and cost savings for Florida's health care delivery system.

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
