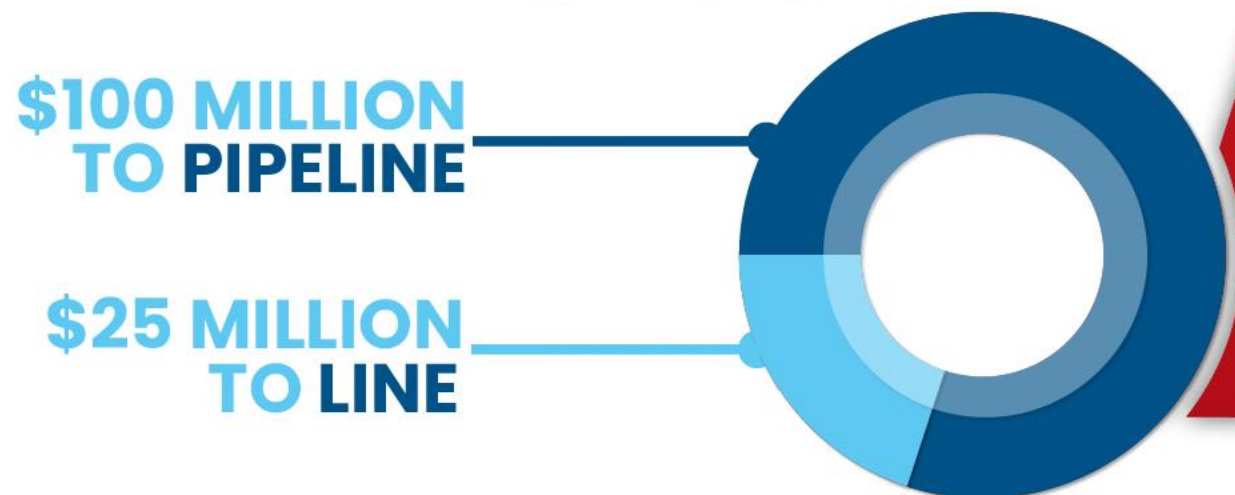

SB2524

PURPOSE:

Incentivize collaboration between nursing education programs and health care partners to meet workforce demands.

WHAT IS LINE?

LINE is a competitive grant program that matches contributions from health care partners to educational institutions (dollar for dollar) to increase the capacity of high-quality nursing education programs and expand Florida's nursing workforce.

THE CHALLENGE

- Florida – like the nation – is experiencing a housing crisis
- There are not enough affordable housing options to support our state’s workforce
- Homeownership is part of the American Dream and an effective way to grow personal wealth
- Yet, financing can be challenging



THE SOLUTION

FHA SECURED \$100 MILLION IN STATE FUNDING TO ESTABLISH A HOMETOWN HEROES HOUSING PROGRAM

- The program makes home ownership affordable to essential workers in Florida

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

- Health Care Professionals
- Childcare Providers
- Law Enforcement Officers
- Active Military
- Firefighters
- Veterans
- Teachers

REQUIREMENTS

- Participants must be first-time homebuyers.
- Participants must be income-qualified.
- The home purchased through the program must serve as a primary residence in the community where they work and serve.



BENEFITS

Lower than market rates on an FHA, VA, RD, Fannie Mae or Freddie Mac first mortgage

Reduced upfront fees

Down payment and closing cost assistance
